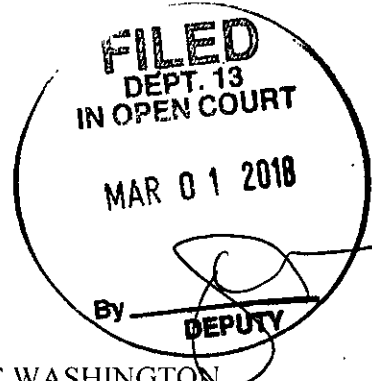

STIPULATED MOTION AND

CONTINUANCE OF DEADLINES

EX PARTE

Plaintiff Todd Wodja and Defendant Washington State Employees Credit Union (collectively the "Parties") respectfully and jointly request entry of the below Order continuing certain deadlines in this matter to allow additional time for necessary determinations on class membership and distribution amounts prior to delivery of class notices.

STIPULATION

The Court's February 2, 2018 Order granting preliminary approval of the Parties' class-action settlement ("Preliminary Approval Order") requires the claims administrator in this case to send class notices "30 days after issuance of this Order" ("Notice Deadline"). Based on the timeline in the Preliminary Approval Order, the Court issued an Order Amending Case Schedule (also on February 2, 2018) setting the final approval hearing for Friday, June 1, 2018 at 9:00AM.

STIPULATED MOTION AND ~~PROPOSED~~ ORDER
CONTINUING DEADLINES - 1

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- Electronic Exparte (3451573) -

1 The Parties have been working cooperatively in ascertaining exactly who needs to receive
2 the class notice and proper amount of distributions under the Settlement Agreement. That
3 process has taken somewhat longer than the Parties anticipated, and final determinations will not
4 be made before the current Notice Deadline. In addition, the Claims Administrator will need
5 several business days to process the information, and then to format and deliver the class notices.

6 Because all other deadlines in the Preliminary Approval Order are based on the Notice
7 Deadline, amendment of the Notice Deadline will also extend all other corresponding deadlines
8 in the Order. The parties believe that a 21-day continuance of the deadline to send class notices
9 will allow the Parties sufficient time to finalize class-member and distribution determinations so
10 that the claims administrator can send class notices.

11 **ORDER**

12 Based on the foregoing Stipulation and the Court having found good cause to grant the
13 relief requested, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT


14 The Court's February 2, 2018 Preliminary Approval Order and the Court's February 2,
15 2018 Order Amending Case Schedule are hereby amended as follows:

- 16 a. Deadline for claims administrator to send notice: **March 23, 2018**
17 b. Deadline for class members to opt out: **May 6, 2018**
18 c. Deadline for motion for final approval and attorneys' fees: **May 11, 2018**
19 d. Deadline for class members to object: 15 days after Motion for Final Approval is
20 filed.
21 e. Deadline for class counsel or defendant's counsel to file responses to any
22 objections and to provide list of opt outs: 7 days after deadline to object.
23 f. Hearing on final approval: **June 22, 2018**
24 g. Preliminary deadline for filing of Final Accounting: 30 days after time to cash
25 checks has expired.
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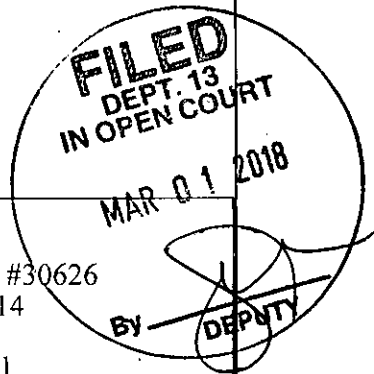
